

Guidelines for a Thesis Presentation in the Department of Culture and Media (KM)

1. A thesis presentation is scheduled for 40-60 minutes (depending on degree level), and includes the following:

	BA	MA
Student presentation	20 minutes	30 minutes
Examiner comments	10 minutes	10 minutes
Q&A from others in attendance	5 minutes	10 minutes
Final comments and instructions from Supervisor	5 minutes	10 minutes

2. Your 30 minute presentation is an opportunity to discuss your own findings and recommendations. These are the most important sections to emphasise, so be careful not to spend too much time on some of the other sections and be rushed at the end.

- a. A *guide* for how to manage your time could be:

Purpose and aim/goals of study	2 minutes	2 minutes
Key questions of study	2 minutes	2 minutes
Brief overview of literature review and theoretical framework	4 minutes	5 minutes
Methodology	4 minutes	5 minutes
Findings and recommendations	8 minutes	10 minutes

3. It is usually more engaging for the audience if you include slides or other visual elements.
 - a. Please choose to use media clips carefully as they could take valuable time you could be using to discuss findings. Include them only if absolutely important for your own work.
4. Remember that the audience may not be familiar with all the concepts in your field, so include definitions were needed.
