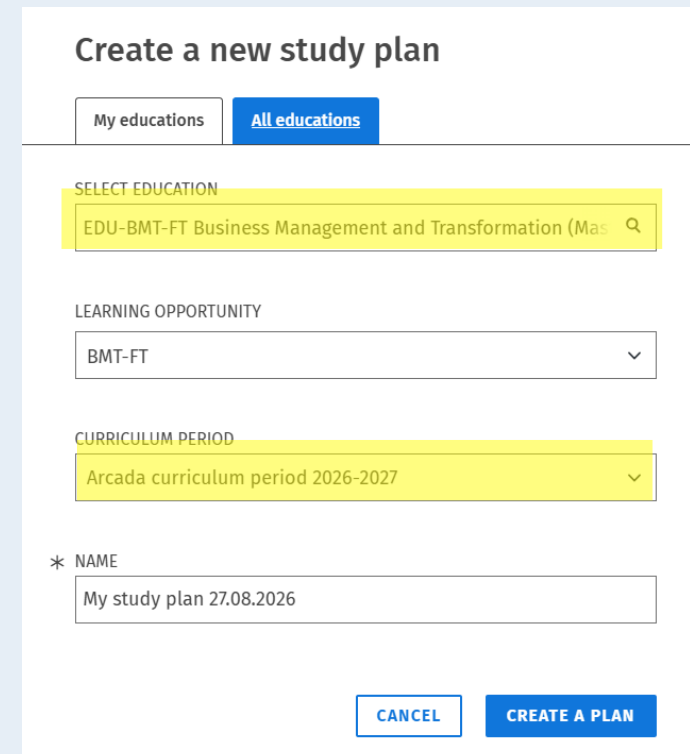
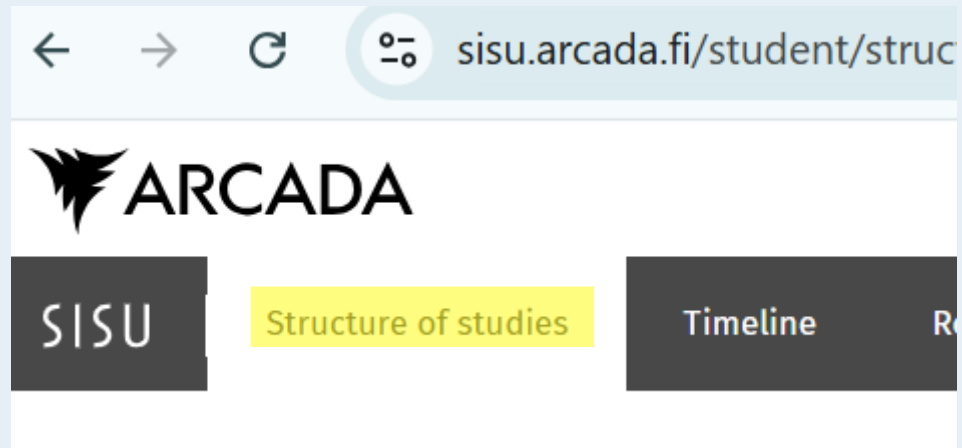


- Go to sisu.arcada.fi on the frontpage you can see different tabs, go to **My profile**

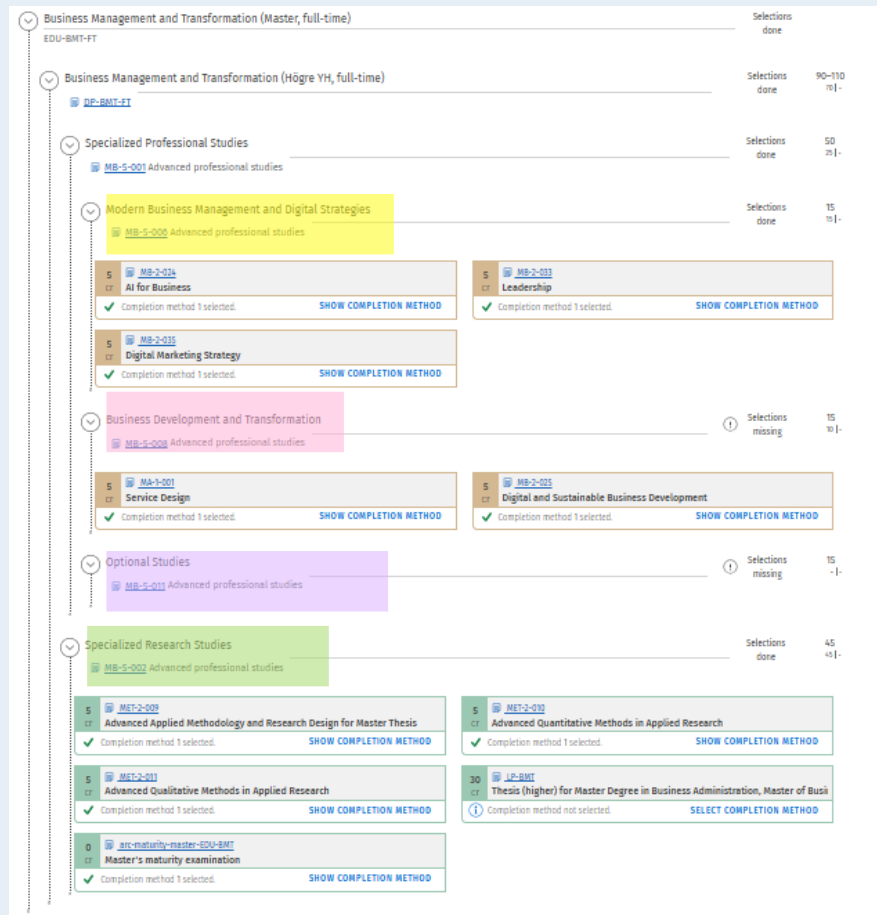
under My profile you have different tabs again, go to **Personal information** check that all is correct

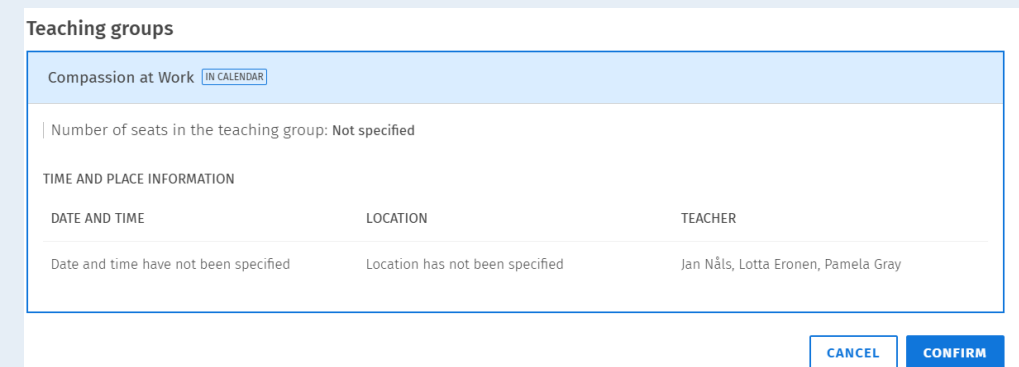
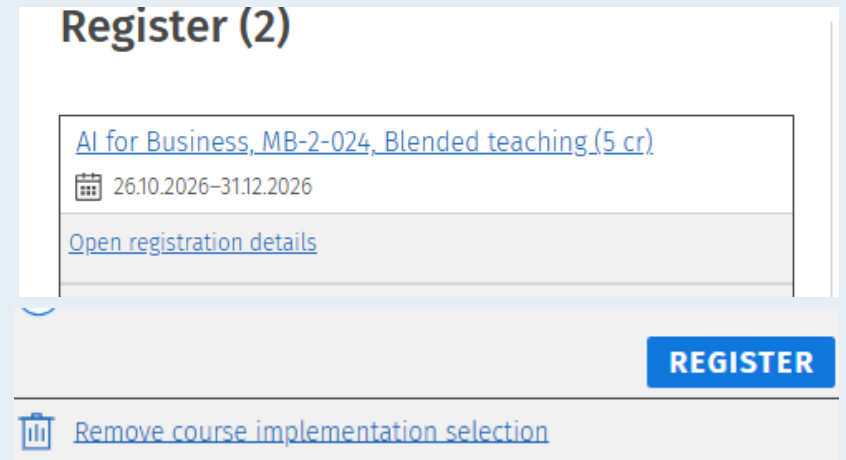
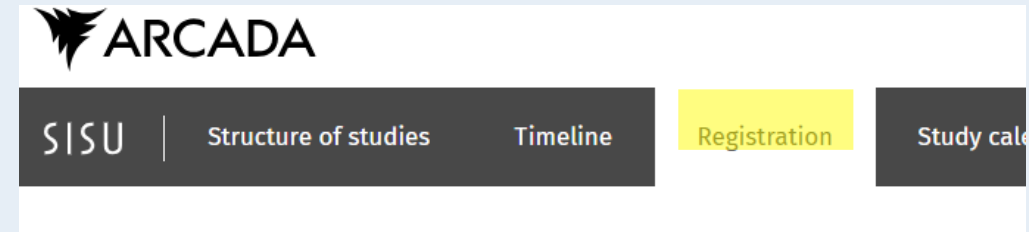
Enroll to courses (1/2)

- The fastest way is to enroll through your study plan. Go to the study plan you created, in tab **Structure of studies**
- Start by clicking on a course code shown in blue
- Go to tab **Completion methods** and click **SELECT**
- And after this you need to go to the tab **Registration** (see next slide)



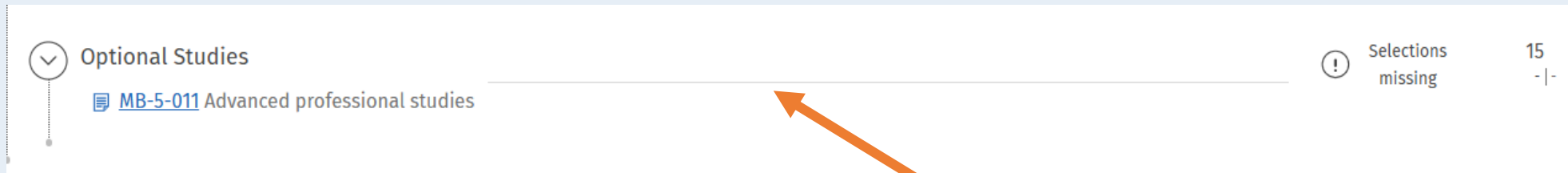
Enroll to courses (2/2)

- To enroll to the course, go to Registration
- Find all courses you have selected, and click the tab **REGISTER**
- As a last step, click on the tab **CONFIRM**
- Follow the same steps for the other courses



Add courses to your study plan (1/2)

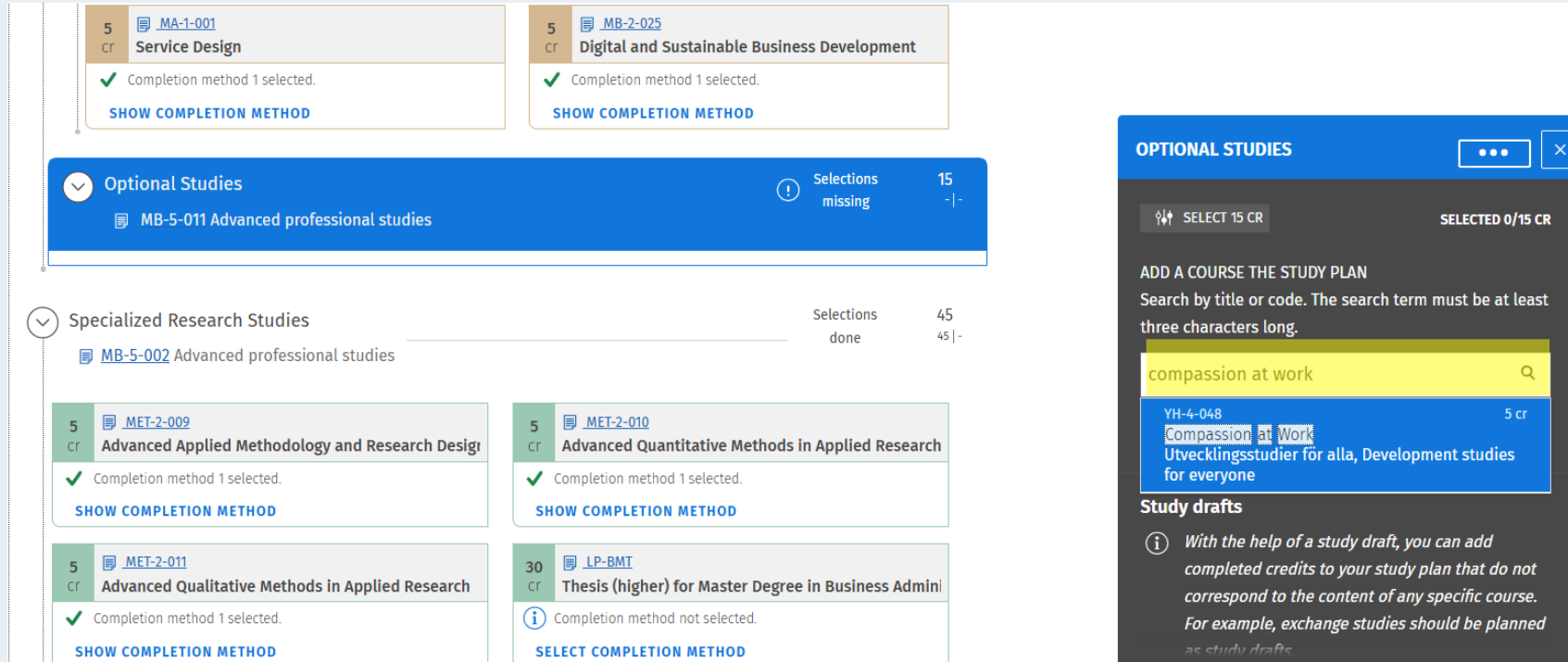
- All courses are already in your study plan, except for your **free optional studies**. At this point you don't need to add any courses in this module. You will get more information on optional studies at the introduction day. For you who study **full-time**, it is recommended that you take one optional study during the autumn semester.



- You can add courses to the module by clicking on the **line** (click on the line not the text).
